- Studies of Serum Desmosterol Levels in Hypercholesteremic Subjects Treated with  
 Triparanol (MER-29) . . . . . 760

Desmosterol is the immediate precursor of cholesterol. There is evidence that certain drugs such as triparanol (MER-29) act as an inhibitor in the step between desmosterol and cholesterol. In this interesting study during which triparanol was given for prolonged periods, the relative changes in the two serum sterol levels were investigated. The progressive increase in serum desmosterol level raises certain, as yet unanswered, questions.
